We need continued reliable and accessible care for people with HIV in the future. What can and what should this look like?

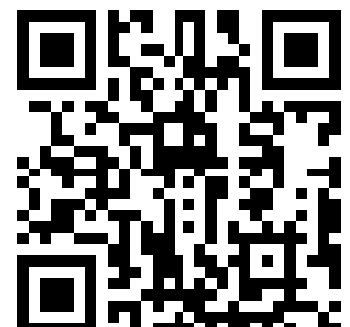
